3. Each tune is offered in several skill levels, to accommodate increases in your skill level as you work through the book.

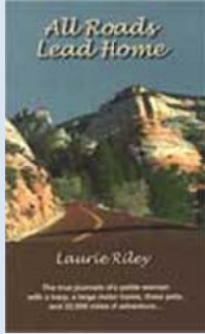
